KEYNOTE SPEAKER Benjamin Hoffman, M.D., FAAP, CPST-I hoffmanb@ohsu.edu

Benjamin Hoffman is a semi-native of New Mexico. He majored in Anthropology at the University of California at Berkeley, and attended Harvard Medical School. He completed residency training, and a year as Chief Resident, at Seattle Children's Hospital. Following training,

he and his wife, Jane, also a pediatrician, spent four years on the Navajo Nation with the Indian Health Service, where he worked with the community to develop a child passenger safety program. He has been certified as a CPS technician since 1997, and an instructor since 2001. From 2000–2011, he was at the University of New Mexico, where he was director of the pediatric residency program, developed and ran a community advocacy training program for pediatric residents, and worked to draft and advocate for childhood injury prevention legislation.

Ben is a nationally recognized expert in child passenger safety, and leader in the field of community health and advocacy training for pediatric residents. He practices and teaches in Portland, OR, where he is very active in community advocacy.
